

**FINAL NOTICE OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION (DPF-31B)

CHARGES:

1. N.J.A.C. 4A:2-2.3(a):

- 1. Incompetency, inefficiency, or failure to perform duty

SPECIFICATIONS:

You are a Public Safety Telecommunicator in the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office, Public Safety Telecommunications Division.

On September 15, 2008 you improperly handled a 911 call by failing to dispatch a police officer when a caller advised her husband violated a restraining order by coming onto school property and being near her.

On September 15 2008 you received a 911 call from a female caller that she had a permanent restraining order against someone and he had just violated it by coming onto school property, that is, the parking lot. You asked the called what town she was in and the caller responded Tinton Falls at Monmouth Regional High School. You then asked if she had called the Police and she replied that was what she was doing now. You told her you could give her the telephone number. When she asked for the number you gave it to her and she hung up.

Approximately five minutes later, your coworker Public Safety Telecommunicator Kelly Munson received a 911 call from the same female caller advising she had been given the wrong telephone number for the police. PST Munson took the information and dispatched the Tinton Falls Police.

You failed to dispatch a police officer, failed to demonstrate comprehension of the serious potential of the situation by failing to ask questions when alerted the matter was taking place on school property. You also failed to enter the call into the CAD (Computer Aided Dispatch) system as required.

Your department has recommended the disciplinary action of a six (6) day suspension without pay is upheld.

Please be advised a repeat of this or other unacceptable behavior will result in stronger disciplinary action being recommended up to recommending your separation of employment with the County of Monmouth.
