

MINUTES of the regular meeting of the Somerset/Middlesex Area Libertarians, April 19, 2005, at the home of Barry Allen, 130 S. Lakeside Dr., Piscataway, NJ 08854. The meeting was called to order at 8:05 P.M. by Vice\_Chairman Frank Warren. Howard Schoen, recorded the minutes. Also present were members Barry Allen, Kevin Pearce, and Jim Harshman, and Rutgers campus Libertarian activist Darian Worden.

Responding to a request from Open Government Task Force Chairman John Paff, Barry Allen moved that "the Open Government Task Force", originally resolved to disband on March 31, 2005, shall remain in force until May 31, 2005.

Frank announced that because "Meet Up" was now requiring a fee, he was planning on removing our participation. There was no objection.

Frank announced that he is running for Assembly in the 21<sup>st</sup> district and that he needs a running mate. He also reported that the Chairman of the State Party candidate assistance committee had resigned.

Darian Worden reported on Rutgers Campus activities. He is trying to get his organization recognized for next year.
